The Next Step

12 Step Abstinent Recovery Housing

- **Referral Criteria:**
- Identifies as an addict.
- Abstinent from both Drugs & Alcohol.
- Engagement in a 12 Step programme, or TC wing while in custody.
- Local Connection to Blackpool.

Exclusions:

- OST substitute prescribing such as Methadone/Buvidal etc.
- Prescribed opioid pain relief medication/ gabapentoids, to be discussed on an individual basis, with the expectation of a medication review , and reduction if medically appropriate.
- Registration on a sexual offences register that's current.

Exclusions Continued:

- Arson offences, if after a risk assessment, insurance liability would be denied to the organisation.
- Licence conditions that make it impossible for us to house someone in a specific location.
- 12 Step programme is not for them.
- Severe & Enduring mental health.

Living at JFH, Requirement:

- Engagement with a 12 Step sponsor.
- Regular Mutual Aid meeting attendance.
- Once a week in house group.
- Weekly house food shopping budget.

Living at JFH Support Offer.

- Safe secure accommodation.
- Access to a vibrant recovery community.
- In house peer support.
- 7 day a week staff engagement.
- Support to address any outstanding debts which may stop future accommodation options

Handbook

- The handbook sets out the day to day expectations, terms and conditions of living in JFH, these range:
 - From staying out overnight, overnight guests, code of conduct, emergency contacts, complaints procedure.
 - General conditions of your licence agreement such as staff may search your room without permission.
 - Payment of rent including any top up requirements.

The non negotiables

- No drugs or alcohol on the premises at any time, this includes no visitors under the influence.
- No committing crime, anti-social behaviour, bullying or harassment of housemates, staff or community members.
- No smoking in communal areas (smoking is permitted in your own room and outside spaces)
- No children or young people on the premises overnight.
- Disregard for JFH property.
- No overnight guests.
- Refusal to engage with support programmes

Drug/Alcohol use.

- We do not operate a testing regime, though we will if deemed necessary require testing if there is a suspicion of use. If your licence condition require regular tests, probation will arrange this separately.
- Admission of Drug/Alcohol use, we operate a system of giving you the opportunity to stop and re-engage in your recovery programme
- Full relapse to addiction – we will support you in finding alternative accommodation, and continue to support you in the community, if appropriate.
